Linking up with the Swiss image of cleanliness, this work denotes health and a desire for perfection. Seven pressure-activated lamps are attached to my body, each associated with a melodic phrase that I sing when it's illuminated, and which stops when I press on the same lamp again to turn it off. Interrupting sentences, I give them different meanings, playing with the languages (german and french), the sound of the words, and onomatopoeic effects.

On the small white table that I use as a stage, I move, gesticulate and dance according to the score for seven lamps that I imposed to myself. The lamps on me are the reflects of my obsessions but also of my physical pains, like sensitive points in acupuncture. I would like to control them, tame them but they challenge me and impose me a certain flexibility anyway. Putzfrau seen as a game between songs and body was presented during *High Calibre* in Berlin, *Digital Art Weeks* in Zurich and *Pas du Jeu* in Martigny.
